

1st Merrickville Necker Manufacture



Neckers are manufactured in four sizes:

Beaver	24" x 24" x 33 ¾"
Cub	28" x 28" x 39 ½"
Scout	31" x 31" x 46"
Leader	36" x 36" x 51"

Sewing instructions:

1. Cut a right isosceles triangle of the main colour.
2. Cut strips, 2 3/8" wide, of the trim colour.
3. Fold these strips in half, press, open out, and press raw edges half way into centre fold. Similar to bias tape.
4. Attach the strips to the raw edges of the triangles and finish the ends by turning inside. The stripes on the edges should ¾" wide.
5. Finish the long edge of the necker.

The long hem should be marked with a 'B', 'C', 'S', or 'L' for easy identification and storage.
